About College:

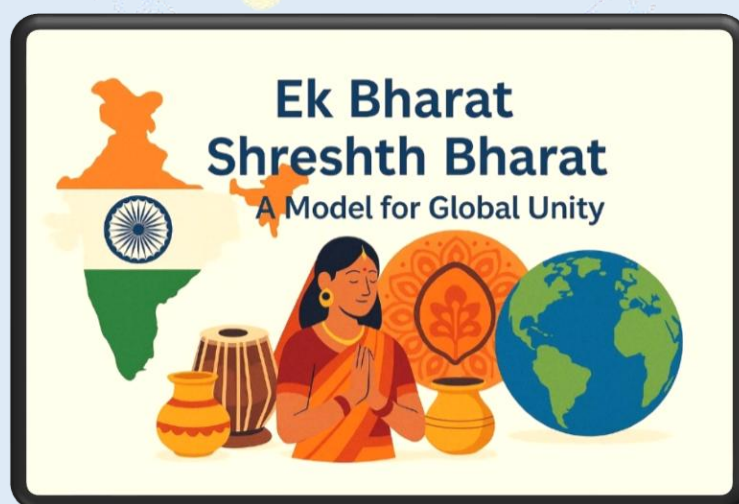
